Floridapublicnotices.com is owned and operated by the Florida Press Service, a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Florida Press Association. FPS strives to provide a convenient and personalized way to search for public notices and legal notices published in various newspapers throughout the state.

By using floridapublicnotices.com, you agree to the provisions contained in this User Agreement.

1. Disclaimer of Responsibility

The Florida Press Service is not responsible for any newspaper that discontinues their participation on floridapublicnotices.com. FPS is also not responsible for technical difficulties experienced by a newspaper that results in notices not being uploaded for a specific day or time period.

FPS does not guarantee that floridapublicnotices.com will be uninterrupted or error-free, nor does FPS guarantee that all information obtained from this site will meet your expectations. FPS also does not guarantee that the public notices and legal notices the newspapers upload to this site are always accurate or complete.

2. Registration

In order to view the public and legal notices on floridapublicnotices.com, you must agree to provide an e-mail address to obtain your password. We also ask for profession, income, and zip code, of which you have the option to not disclose one or all of them. The e-mail address is used to verify a valid registration is submitted. If at any time you choose to no longer be a part of floridapublicnotices.com, simply do not return to the site. **Once you submit registration information, it cannot be deleted, it simply becomes inactive.**

3. Purchasing the E-mail Notification and Archived Notices feature *(These two features are currently FREE of charge, but may become PAID features in the future)*

The following information are the Terms and Conditions you agree to when purchasing these two features...

- i. You must allow at least 24 hours for your order to be processed.
- ii. By purchasing these features, you agree to the User Agreement, Privacy Policy, and Terms and Conditions of floridapublicnotices.com
- iii. If option 1 is purchased (1 month) and you choose to cancel, you will only be refunded if you cancel **within 15 days** of the start date. For all other options, you will only be refunded if you cancel **within 30 days** of the start date. To cancel, contact the Florida Press Service at 850.222.6401 and ask to cancel your floridapublicnotices.com e-mail/archive subscription.
- iv. The Florida Press Service is not responsible for any newspaper that discontinues their participation on floridapublicnotices.com. FPS is also not responsible for technical difficulties experienced by a newspaper that results in notices not being uploaded for a specific day or time period. **No refunds will be given because a newspaper discontinues participation or has technical difficulties.**
- v. Please note, if using the E-mail Notification feature and there are no public notices that match your search criteria for that day, you will still receive an e-mail, but there will be

no notices listed in the body of that e-mail. **No refunds will be given because notices are not matching your "Favorite" search criteria. Refer to the "Search Tips" page to help you search for specific notices.**

- vi. If using the Archived Notices feature, please note that you can only search as far back as 12 months. The summer of 2002 is when the first newspaper began uploading, and the number of newspapers has gradually increased, and will continue to grow over time. *It is important that you understand not all newspapers will have notices available in the archives.* **No refunds will be given because specific notices you're searching for are not found. Refer to the "Search Tips" page to help you search for specific notices.**

Privacy Policy

The information gathered from registering on floridapublicnotices.com includes e-mail, profession, income level, and zip code. Registering allows FPS and the newspapers of Florida to better understand the type of individuals using public notices and legal notices. With this understanding, FPS has the opportunity to better market this service, and provide feedback to local governments about who values and relies on public notices and legal notices the most.

When registering, you have the option not to disclose profession, income, and/or zip code. E-mail is needed in order to retrieve a password. E-mail addresses are not distributed to anyone outside of the Florida Press Service and are not used for commercial purposes at this time. In the event you receive an e-mail from us, you will have the option to prevent any future e-mails.

The information gathered when purchasing the E-mail Notification and Archived Notices feature is not distributed to anyone outside of the Florida Press Service/Florida Press Association. It is used only for verifying legitimacy and processing of payment.
